## **CSN Career Fair Helps Students & Companies Connect**

The September 18 event will include dozens of employers and is free and open to the public

September 11, 2019 – The College of Southern Nevada will soon host its Fall 2019 Career Fair, connecting students and other job seekers with local employers. The event is scheduled for 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. September 18 in the June Whitley Student Lounge on CSN's North Las Vegas campus. It is free and open to the public.

This year, the Career Fair is in partnership with Project 354, a coalition of workforce development agencies whose purpose is reducing double digit unemployment in zip codes 89030 and 89106. The program supports AB354, which was sponsored by Assemblywoman Dina Neal during the 2017 legislative session.

The career fair's open forum allows job applicants to meet recruiters from local businesses both large and small, learn about job openings and in some cases apply on the spot. Applicants should be prepared for interviews, including having resumes on hand and dressing in interview attire.

"Our career fairs offer students a great opportunity to connect with many different employers in one time and place," said Bradford Glover, director of Career & Transfer Services at CSN. "Many job seekers use it as a way to learn more about employers. Recruiters will also be there to talk with applicants about their organizations and the jobs available. This is one way that CSN is helping to expand and diversify Southern Nevada's workforce."

In addition to the Career Fair, there will be a job prep event co-sponsored by CSN and Project 354 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. September 17 in the same location. This event will offer tips on how to "dress for success," help with resume writing and mock job interviews.

Some of the four dozen companies planning to attend the Career Fair include: Amazon, Cashman Equipment, Chick-fil-A, the Clark County School District, the North Las Vegas Police Department, the Cosmopolitan of Las Vegas, Station Casinos and many more.
